

NEW REGULATIONS

ARE NOW IN FORCE

These new regulations have been put in place to help those responsible for high rise buildings Think Safe, Act Safe and therefore enable residents to Be Safe.

WHAT DOES THIS NEW REGULATION MEAN?

Those responsible persons of high-rise blocks of flats must provide information to fire and rescue services so they can adopt and apply an efficient and effective operational response.

WHAT ARE THESE NEW REGULATIONS?

BUILDING PLANS

Provide fire and rescue services with up to date building floor plans in a secure information box on site.

EXTERNAL WALL SYSTEMS

Provide information about the design and materials of a high-rise building's external wall system and inform of any material changes made.

LIFTS AND KEY FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT

Undertake monthly checks on lifts and fire-fighting equipment and report any defects.

WAY FINDING SIGNAGE

Install signage in stairwells that is visible in low light or smokey conditions that identifies flats and floor numbers.

FIRE DOORS

Check flat entrance doors and all fire doors.

FIRE SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Provide relevant fire safety instruction to residents.

FIRE DOOR INFORMATION

Provide residents with information relating to the importance of fire doors.
